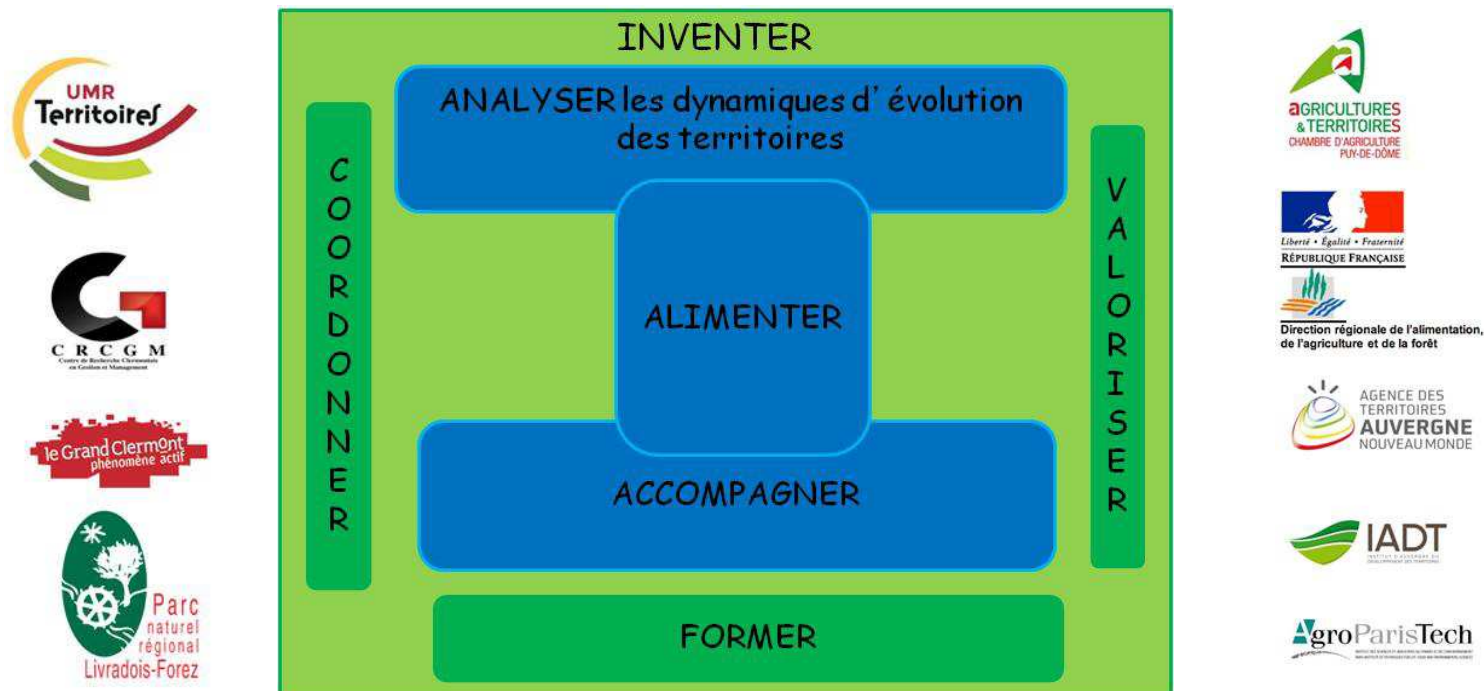

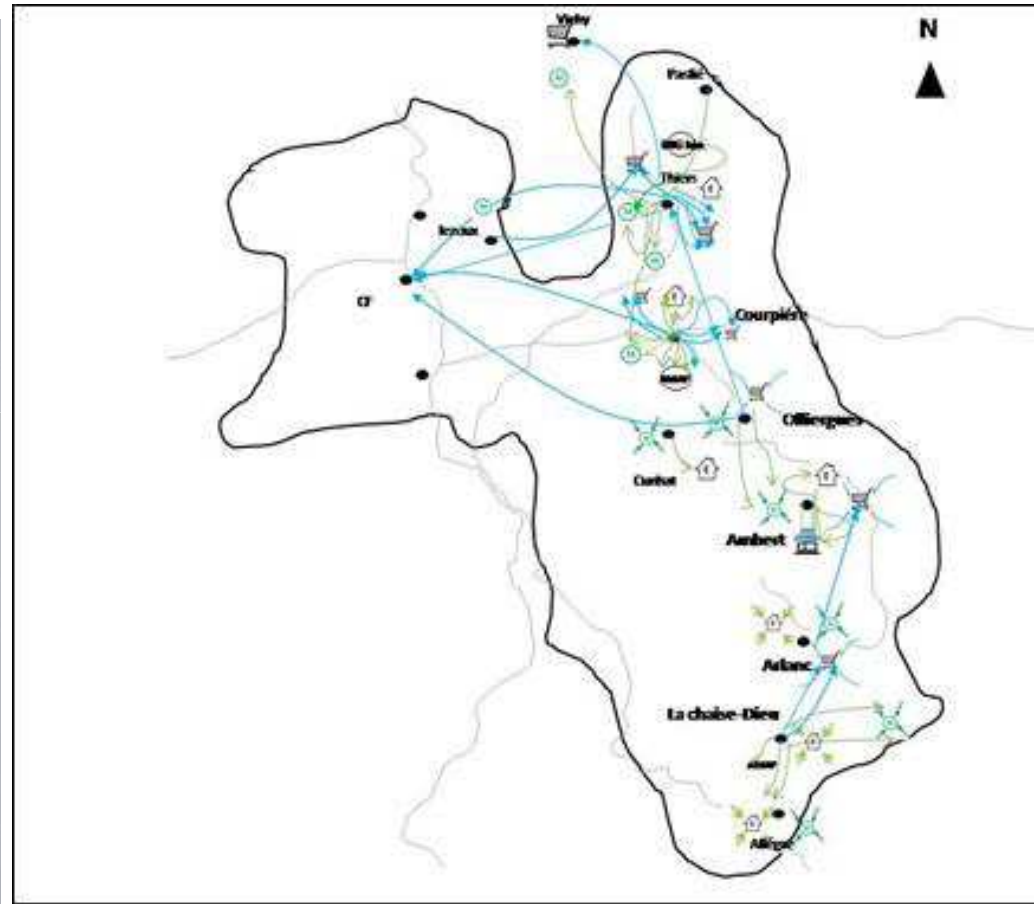
The project aims to formalize the development dynamics of rural and metropolitan territories based on food governance and to design the process for guiding change via a Research-Training-Action mechanism.
